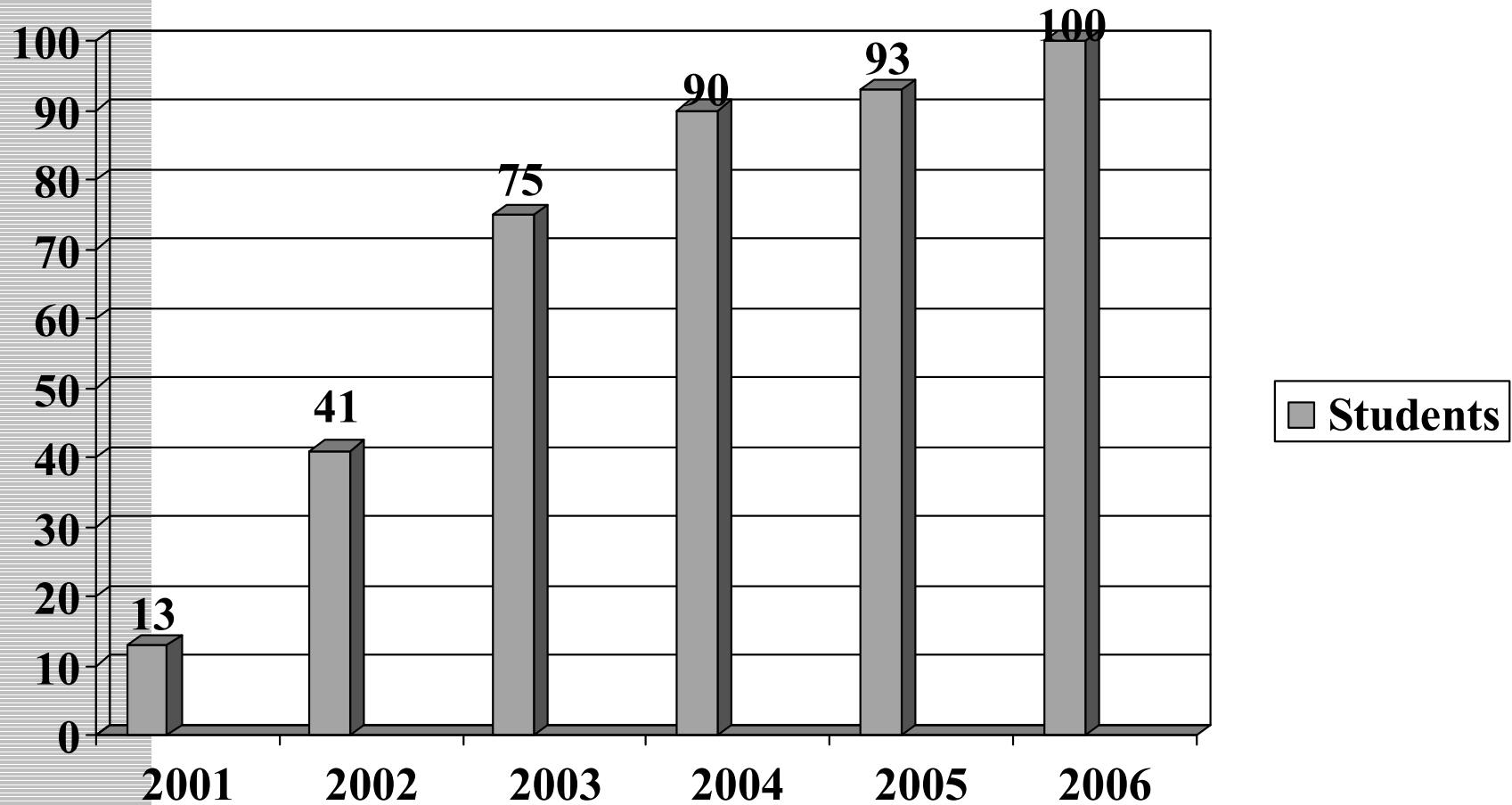
School History - 1998

- **Incorporated**
- **Certified by the state of North Carolina as a private school**
- **Open with three students and two staff members**

Milestones

- **Received designation as a 501(c)3 organization in 2000**
- **Hired N.C. Certified Lead Teacher in 2001 with K4 through Third Grade with 13 students.**
- **Added Fourth Grade in 2002**
- **Added Fifth Grade in 2003**
- **First fifth grader graduated in 2004.**
- **To date 10 fifth graders have graduated**

School Profile

- **School Opens on July 17, 2006 with:**
 - 100 students
 - 7 Teachers
 - 5 Assistants
- **The goal since inception has been to maintain small class sizes with ratios no greater than 1:19. Our current ratio of teachers to students is 1:14.5. Including assistants, that ratio is 1:8.3**

Student Population – 2005-2006

- **46 Female students or 49% of the student population**
- **47 Male students or 51% of the student population**
